Build Your French Online | Course Description

Level: A1+/A2

Welcome to Build Your French Online A1+/A2

This course is designed for learners who are developing their French from A1+ towards A2. Whether you want to refresh the basics or take the next step in your learning, the course offers a supportive space to practise, consolidate and develop your French at your own pace.

Grammar and Sentence Structures

The course may include revision and development of areas such as:

- Present tense and common irregular verbs
- *Passé composé* and an introduction to the *imparfait*
- Near future (*futur proche*) and simple future forms
- Modal verbs and useful expressions for everyday communication
- Possessive adjectives
- Direct and indirect object pronouns
- Reflexive verbs
- Comparisons and superlatives

These are examples of language areas that may be explored during the course. Your teacher may adapt the programme according to the needs of the group, revisiting key A1 language where necessary and introducing A2 material when learners are ready.

Communication Skills

During the course, you will have the chance to:

- Talk about yourself, your family, your daily routine and your interests
- Describe people, places and everyday situations
- Talk about what you did and what you are going to do
- Express likes, dislikes, preferences and simple opinions
- Give simple instructions, advice and recommendations
- Talk about plans, arrangements and future intentions

The aim is to help you build on what you already know, strengthen your French and take the next step towards communicating more confidently in everyday situations.

Build Your French Online | Course Description

Level: A2+/B1

Welcome to Build Your French Online A/B1

This course is designed for learners who are working towards B1 level and may be starting from different points between mid-A2 and early B1. Whether you want to fill gaps in your knowledge or move forward with your French, this course gives you the opportunity to learn, practise, progress and revise at your own level.

Grammar and Sentence Structures

The course may include revision, consolidation and development of areas such as:

- Past tenses (*Passé composé & Imparfait*)
- Future forms and the conditional
- Comparative and superlative forms
- Direct and indirect object pronouns
- Relative pronouns (*qui, que, où*)
- Expressing cause, consequence, purpose and contrast

Please note that these grammar points are examples of what might be covered. The course is designed to respond to the needs and level of the group.

Communication Skills

Throughout the course, you will have opportunities to:

- Talk about routines, habits, experiences and personal interests
- Talk about the past, present and future
- Express opinions, preferences, hopes and intentions
- Give reasons and explain your ideas
- Build longer and more structured spoken and written messages
